The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) is hosting a meeting to update you on the next phase of our plan to improve water quality in your watershed.

When: Thursday, June 27, 2013  
Beginning at 6:00 pm

Where: Spokane Fire District 4, Station 46  
3799 E Deer Park Milan Road  
(west of Riverside High School)

The primary goal of this phase will be to reduce the amount of nutrients in the Little Spokane River. Too many nutrients in a stream can reduce the amount of oxygen in the water for fish and cause other problems. Also, reducing nutrients in the Little Spokane River will help improve conditions in Lake Spokane.

The previous phase of water quality improvement project addressed bacteria, temperature, and turbidity. During the meeting, we will also provide an update on this effort.
